- Commissioning of a new bus service to provide public transport access to Morpeth for citizens of the Parish and beyond;
- Thanks to NCC Councillor Glen Sanderson, Dee Smith our Parish Clerk and the Dyke Neuk for their continued support.


RESOLVED
