26. **Chairman's Announcements**

The Chairman welcomed everyone present.

27. **Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations on this occasion.

28. **Public Participation Time**

A member of the public reported issues regarding verge cutting and speeding in Pigdon.

29. **Co-option – Three Vacancies in the Office of Councillor**

- a. Members were advised that there are currently two vacancies on the Parish Council. Members were asked to consider co-option for these vacancies.
- b. Members were asked to consider a response to a request from NCC regarding a decrease in council membership.

RESOLVED

- a. Members noted the two vacancies on the Council.
- b. Members agreed a membership of 6, down from 9 members. This is due to the low electorate, no services or assets and the issue of retaining members on the council.

30. Northumberland County Councillor Update

NCC Councillor Glen Sanderson gave the following update:

- Looking at the next budget, £15m down on government settlement. Not looking at cutting frontline services or removing free parking in town centres. The BEST transformation programme is looking at how NCC can save money and become more efficient, including looking at improvements to call centres.
- SEN children transport and adult social care costs are rising.
- Library review taking place.
- Working with the North East Mayor, Kim McGuinness, regarding dualling the A1.
- After the incident on the River Tyne, 15 tonne of nurdles went into the water and are now washing up on Northumberland beaches. At this time, volunteers are picking up the nurdles however, to date, less than 10% have been retrieved. The nurdles are now spreading in the water north and south. Questions are being asked about who is going to decide when to stop looking for nurdles and who will make that decision.
- From October 2026, officers will follow a new delegation scheme when considering planning application, unless they are major applications. This means, that applications will be given to officers to decide unless there is a strong reason for them to go to committee.
